WHEREAS, a primary concern today is the inactive lifestyle of today's youth, which is associated with critical health issues including obesity, type II diabetes and cardiovascular disease; and,

WHEREAS, participation in youth sports is declining, with an estimated 70% of participants dropping out before high school; and,

WHEREAS, to help address these issues the IAPD is taking an active role in supporting an Illinois Youth Sport Summit, organized by the Office of Recreation & Park Resources at the University of Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the summit will take place September 23-25 in Chicago and will bring together individuals from a wide array of agencies and organizations within the state; and,

THEREFORE, I, Pat Quinn, Governor of the State of Illinois, do hereby proclaim September 23, 2014 as **ILLINOIS YOUTH SPORTS DAY** in Illinois, in order to raise awareness about the critical need for making programmatic changes in youth sports that would increase youth participation in sporting activities.
